The Burning of the Valleys Military Association Inc. (**BVMA Inc.**) is composed of units, which re-enact mostly the Revolutionary War in the Mohawk, Schoharie and Upper Hudson Valleys. The war in the valleys, was really a 'civil' war conducted mostly by former neighbors and estranged relatives. In the three year period from 1778 to 1781 a little over two thirds of the valleys were burned to the ground and a little under one third of the civilian population carried away or killed, thus the period was referred to as 'The Destructives'.

This application for membership and all subsequent requests for renewal should be processed through your BVMA affiliated unit if at all possible. If not, then you may contact BVMA Inc. directly using our website at www.BVMA.org. The sustaining membership applies to a Historic Site or Society as a whole. If specific individuals from these sites or societies should wish to join the BVMA Inc. separately, they may do so. They would then become active voting members with all the commensurate rights and privileges. If you don't wish to join the military portion of the organization, then you are free to become a member of the Behind the Lines (**BTL**), or a specific Civilian Distaff or independent Guild member. Our current structure for dues applies to all participating adult members 16 years or older. Any members under the age of 16 are free.

A Sustaining membership for Historic Site or Society is \$ 25.00 per year.

An annual membership in the BVMA is \$ 10.00 per adult over the age of 16.
